



MAEVE



Maeve or “Queen Maeve of Ulster” as Carolyn and Mickey sometimes like to call her is a 4 year-old Rat Terrier rescue. The name Maeve means ‘cause of great joy’ and she was adopted right after Thanksgiving in 2022. Rat terriers were recognized as a breed in 2013; they are a mixture of 7 different breeds, including Whippet, Italian Greyhound, Beagle, Fox Terrier, Manchester Terrier, Old English Terrier, & Bull Terrier. Maeve is a true chatty “rattie.” She has expressive barks, whines, cries, growls, and even trills. These are warbles or shrills that some dogs make when they are excited.

Maeve has some unique behaviors. Flies do not have a chance around Maeve; she is a very efficient flycatcher. Maeve is a ‘Velcro Dog’ meaning that everywhere you go, she has to be there with you. She loves to snuggle and watch TV and loves to be outside where she can watch squirrels, chipmunks, and the occasional rabbit. Maeve has special, individualized greetings for neighbors and the letter carrier. She loves to watch the UPS, Amazon & FedEx trucks bring packages, as she thinks they’re all for her; and sometimes they are! Maeve likes to play with her canine friends Pretzel, Molly, Nina, Emma, Dexter, Gidget and Kona.

Mickey shares that pets add to the health of seniors. Maeve seems to embody that, as she loves on the neighbors and they reciprocate; you can feel the mutual healing. In fact, a recent research study found that living with a dog or cat is associated with slower cognitive decline, in both executive functioning and episodic memory. Many pet owners have known this fact for a while. The title of the research study is: “Longitudinal relationships between pet ownership and cognitive functioning in later adulthood across pet types and individuals’ ages” which was published on May 30, 2025.



Writing the Recipe Box has been an interesting 7 years for me! Friends and neighbors have contributed their cooking ideas, favorite foods, recipes, stories from articles and many suggestions to talk about food! For me, some came naturally, as my grandparents came to the US from Europe, bringing their love for family cooking traditions!

It's a great month to write and cook! During the 30 days of November we celebrate 2 Federal holidays.

VETERAN'S DAY November 11th (the ending of WWII the 11th hour, the 11th day, the 11th month) ... to honor the women and men who served our country in the military.

THANKSGIVING DAY - a celebration assigned on the 4th Thursday of November ... A day to give thanks for sacrifices and hard work.

Cooking has evolved from simplicity and transformed into unique American methods ... one being the Crockpot or Slowcooker!

From Lucy Hubert - for the new residents that have missed her Crockpot entry.....

Turkey Breast - 1 boneless turkey breast, 1 can cranberries (whole or jellied), 1 pkg. dried onion soup mix.

Spray pot with a nonstick product, place turkey breast in the pot, add on top of meat ... cranberries, onion soup mix ... Do not add water! Cook 2 hrs. on high, turn, then cook 4 hrs. on low!

A suggestion from Lucy: A boxed stove top stuffing can be added as a side.

From Barbara Sosinski - for the perfect side:

Mushroom Barley Risotto

2 tbsp EVOO (extra virgin olive oil)

1 lg onion

1 lb. cremini mushrooms sliced

1 1/2 cups barley pearls

4 sprigs thyme

8 oz. carrots chopped fine

1 1/2 cup of water

3 cups of vegetable broth

2/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese

1 tbsp sherry vinegar

1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley

Directions:

1. Heat to medium a large skillet with olive oil. Sauté onions to lightly brown. Add mushrooms, thyme & barley pearls (lightly browned). ADD 1/4 tsp. salt & 1/4 tsp. pepper.

2. Transfer mixture to slow cooker. Add water & carrots. Cook for 3 hrs.

3. Remove thyme sprigs, stir in Parmesan cheese & salt & pepper to taste.

* If too thick, add a little water to thin.

** Garnish with chopped fresh parsley

From Sandy Wood - a 2-step dessert to honor the United States military.

Mama & Daddy's Apple Cobbler

STEP 1

1. preheat oven to 375 degrees

2. prepare...lightly butter a 9 x 9" baking pan,

3. In a large bowl mix together 6 cups of Granny Smith apples, 1/2 cup granulated sugar, 1/4 cup dark brown sugar, 2 tbs. flour, 1 tsp cinnamon, 1 tsp. vanilla, pinch of salt, pinch of nutmeg, juice of 1/2 lemon. Add the mixture to the prepared baking pan

STEP 2

1. In a medium bowl combine to form a batter ... 2 tbs. butter, 1/2 cup self-rising flour, 1/2 cup sugar, pinch of salt, pinch of ground ginger, 1 beaten egg.

2. Dollop the batter in various spots on top of the apple mixture...

3. Bake for 30 mins.

4. Serve with whipped cream....

For those who qualify, please submit your request to assure that you will be placed on the priority list. To qualify, a resident must require regular life-sustaining medical treatment, such as chemotherapy, radiation or dialysis in or outside the home.

A "heart condition" does not qualify. Your request must be accompanied by a **physician script/note** which specifies that life-sustaining treatment for any of the conditions outlined above is necessary. Hand written notes are unacceptable. All information will be kept by the administrator and will be confidential.

For convenience purposes, your doctor may fax this information to our office. Our fax number is 732-920-2650. Please be assured this information will be kept strictly confidential. Placement on the Priority Snow List cannot be accomplished until we receive the necessary documentation from your physician.


Your need to go to work does not qualify for priority snow removal. For this purpose, we suggest you make advance arrangements with a private contractor for snow removal.


