

## Lions Head South Association - 2026 Pool Rules and Regulation

1. **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY**  
Swim at your own risk.
2. All owners/residents and guests 16 or over must; enter their own key fob, have resident pool pass and sign in.
3. **THUNDER AND LIGHTNING**- When thunder occurs, all individuals must leave the pool area. The pool area will be reopened when conditions permit.
4. **FOR SAFETY REASONS**- Pool furniture must be kept at least six (6) feet from the edge of the pool. Pool to remain closed to residents during normal weekly maintenance. If water treatment is required, only at the direction of the Board of Trustees, residents may remain on the deck during treatment. Residents may reenter the pool only after the directed allotted time for schedule allowing for chemical treatment to dissipate.
5. **Diapers are not permitted at any age.**
6. Children 15 or under must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult. Children's hours are Sunday thru Saturday, between 11AM – 1 PM and 5 PM and 8 PM. All day allowance for MemorialDay, 4<sup>th</sup> of July and Labor Day. Children **under 2** are not allowed in the pool.
7. Restrooms will not be used as changing rooms. Dripping bathing suits and bare feet are not allowed in the clubhouse and restroom.
8. Bathers must wear suitable bathing suits or swim wear. Cut-off pants or jeans are not permitted in the pool.
9. Adult flotation objects are limited to noodles and sling chairs. Flotation items, such as inflatable tubes, kickboards, and flippers, are not permitted in the pool. Styrofoam belts and arm "swimmies" will be permitted in the pool when an adult is in the pool with the child.
10. Diving and Jumping are not permitted at any time.
11. Snacks, plastic bottles, and cans are permitted inside the pool area and must be consumed at a table. **NO GLASS OR ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED.** Picnic tables are available outside the pool area for those who have sandwiches, subs, pizza, etc. A charcoal grill is available for your use outside the pool area. A fire shovel and ash can are also provided. Please clean up after use. Garbage and recyclables must be disposed of in the receptacles that are provided outside of the pool entrance.
12. No sports, including ball playing or horseplay, will be permitted in the pool area. Children may have dive toys in the shallow end of the pool. Running is not permitted in the pool area. Loud music is not permitted. Personal music is permitted with earbuds and headsets only.
13. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed in the swimming pool enclosure. (N.J.A.C. 8:26).
14. Smoking and "vaping" are permitted only at in the designated smoking area. Please check signs for smoking allowed. **Smoking and "vaping" are not permitted near the pool area or in any other sports area.**
15. Chairs, tables and lounges are available to residents on first come basis. **THEY MAY NOT BE RESERVED.** Please bring chairs for your guests.
16. Before exiting the pool area, please return chairs and lounges to their regular locations. Umbrellas are to be rolled down to their closed position and tied.
